### **Quinta do Ferro**

Right in the centre of Lisbon, Quinta do Ferro is a small neighbourhood with degraded houses and public spaces where approx. 130 families live there.

The cooperative developed an Urban participated Plan for the requalification of Quinta do Ferro in 2017.

The plan provides for the rehabilitation of houses and the creation of a square, a kindergarten, an underground car park and arrangements of public spaces. It was never approved by the Municipality.

It might be an interesting case study for workshops...
