Aims at developing and testing newer learning/teaching experiences to stimulate students to acquire skills in the regeneration of urban environments, accustoming them to confront the complexity.



Relationship between urban planning, human health, environmental protection, the impact of climate change, and knowledge of participatory processes.











The CLICCHE learning process will use several unconventional educational modalities, such as:

- -Interactive data visualization modalities (virtual, mixed, and augmented reality),
- -Public art
- -Urban simulation game explorations

The project will involve some representative groups of citizens, professionals, and public administrations



















Main objectives

- allowing students to evaluate climate change effects on urban health and equity;
- increasing the students' interest in the topic of urban regeneration;
- innovating the teaching activities by applying a transdisciplinary approach and involving citizens through immersive virtual environments, simulation games, and public art;
- promoting the knowledge in the public administration to develop healthoriented, climate-proof urban plans and projects;
- raising citizens' awareness of climate change's effects on health



CLICCHE Educational methodology and Tool will be integrated into the educational offer of our Universities and can be transferred to other EU Countries











The activities envisaged by the Project concern:

✓ **R1**:Research with the literature review on adaptation strategies against climate change to mitigate the impacts on human health in urban areas CYI will coordinate the R1 Result.

This activity will be presented to students and local stakeholders at the local workshops

✓ R2; R3: Development of a transdisciplinary methodological framework for curriculum design (R2) that will be discussed in a Training course for teachers and researchers (C1) and then, it will originate an educational toolkit for healthy urban planning and urban participation (R3).

✓ The effectiveness of the methodology and tool developed in R2 and R3 will be tested during a series of physical or online local workshops with students at the partner level and will be further tested in the Joint Intensive Course (C2) involving 20 students.

✓ With the support of local workshops and virtual and augmented reality, urbangame simulations, and public art:

- Students will improve their learning knowledge on urban regeneration from the perspective of enhancing urban health, mitigating and adapting to the effects of climate change;
- -Stakeholders will increase their ability to understand the phenomena that affect citizens' health and to learn how to design cities that are more resilient concerning climate change.
- -Public institutions will open a dialogue with universities, citizens, and professionals, combining the aspects of scientific knowledge with the experience of citizens living in neighborhoods and professionals involved in the urban transformation.











√ R4: Development of Guidelines on health practices oriented to climate change adaptation in urban planning (CNR)

It aims at scientifically evaluating the impacts of sound planning practices on human health and identifying within the methodology how to integrate health issues in urban planning and design teaching practices. This part of the project is coordinated by the CNR.


