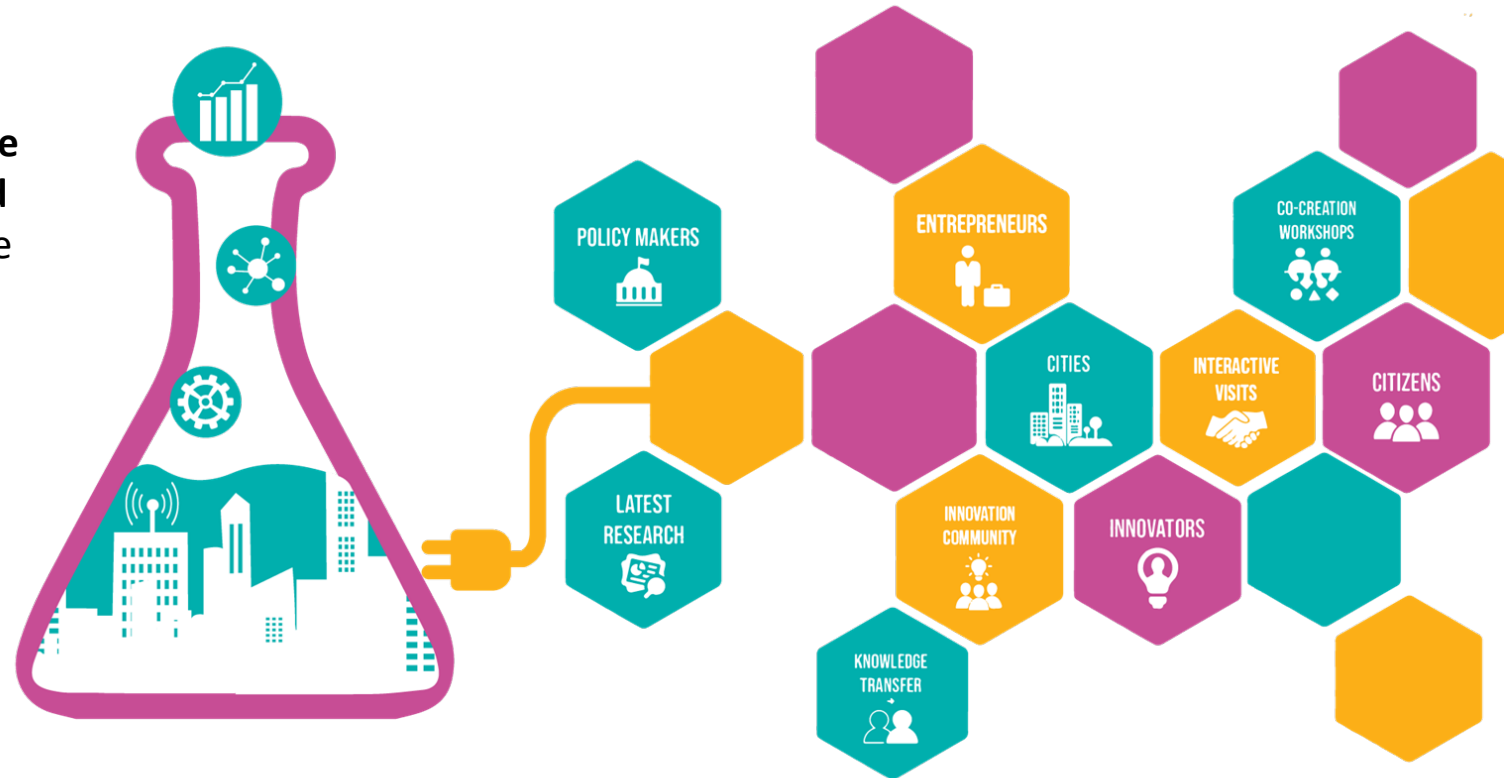


## CLICCHE's challenge

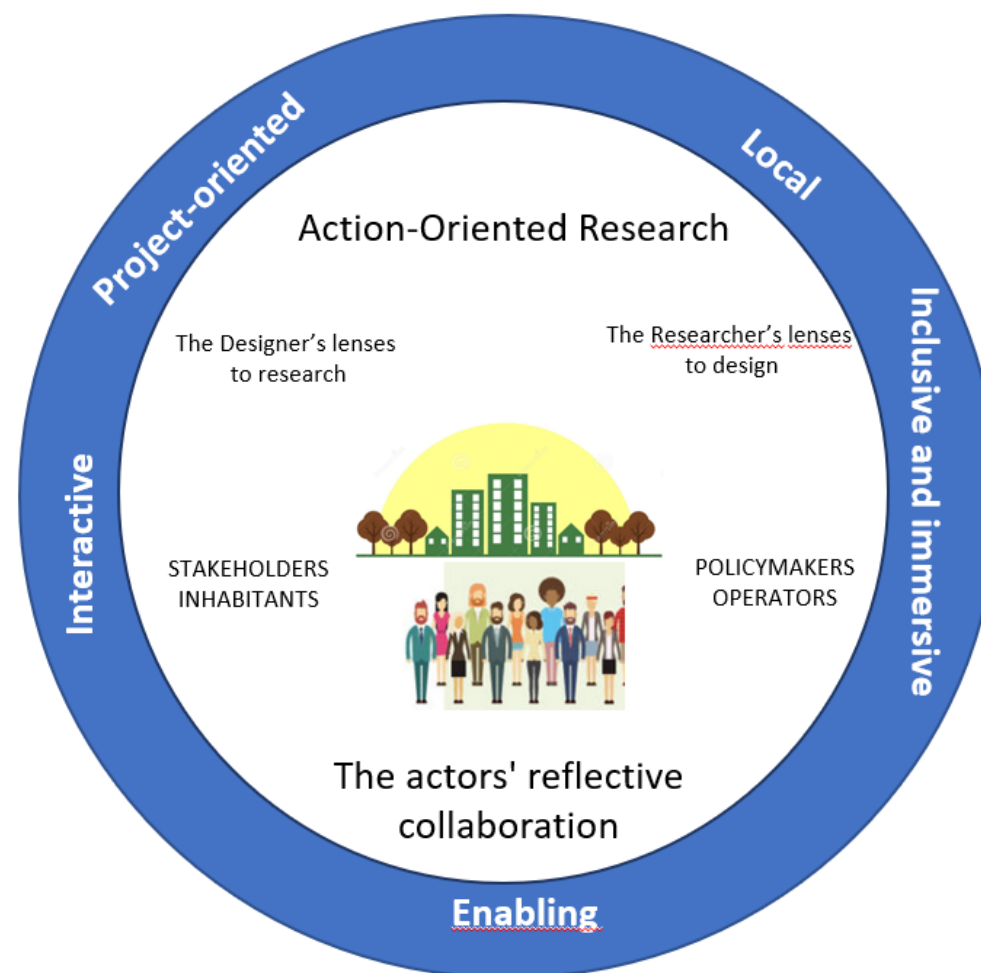

## The methodological approach

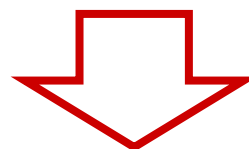
It can be summarized in 5 aspects:

- ✓ Enabling



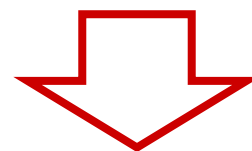
Summary scheme of the "draft" methodology
