

Key facts

Residents: >340,000

Population density: ~1,600 per square kilometre (vs. 131 per square kilometre of the whole island)

Student population: >10,000 in higher education institutions

Public transport: limited bus routes, (free) mini buses with 5G in the old city

Smart mobility: scooters, bikes to rent

Summer temperature maximums: over 40C

Winter temperature minimums: below 1C

Not a walkable city
