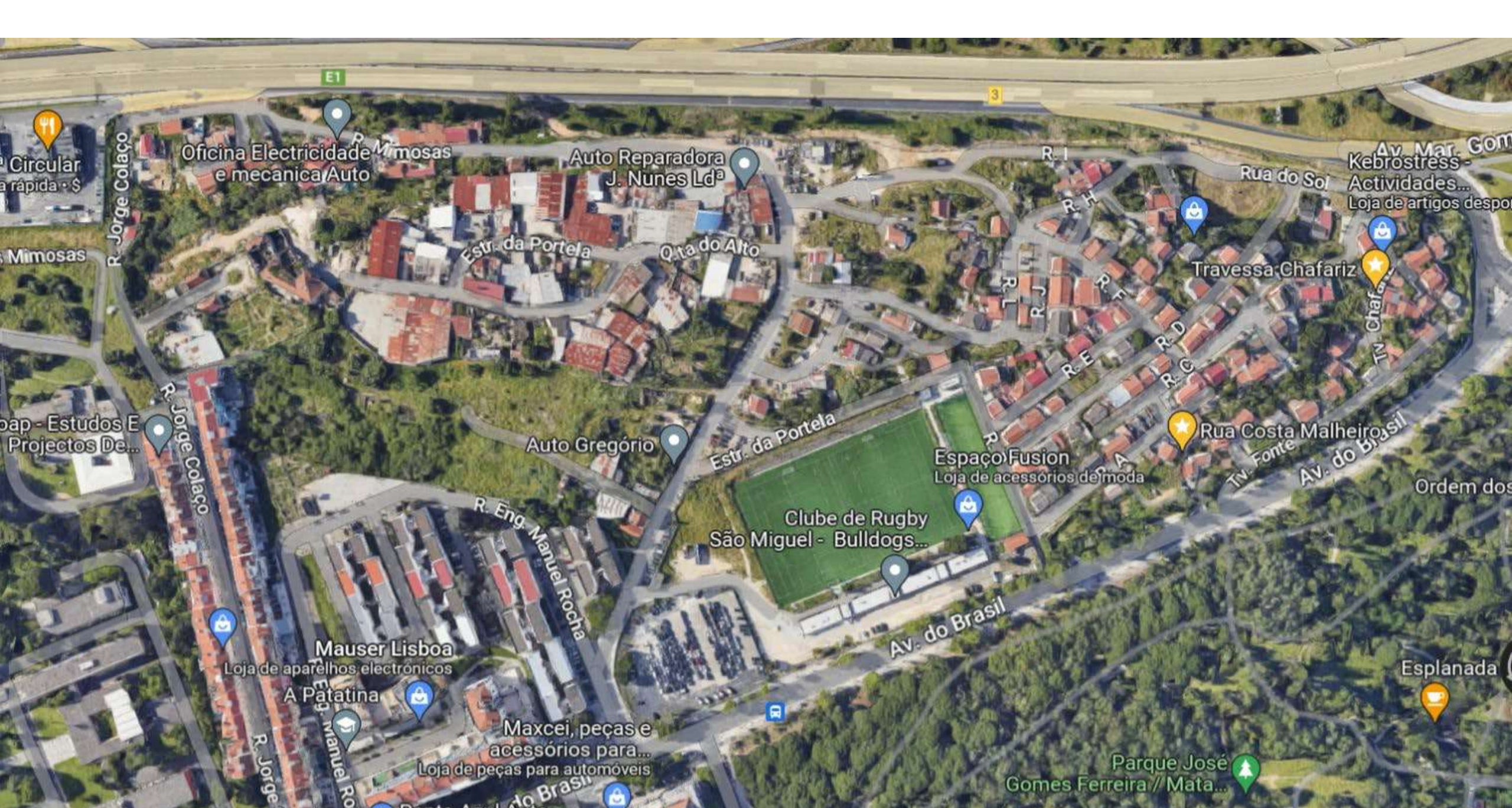

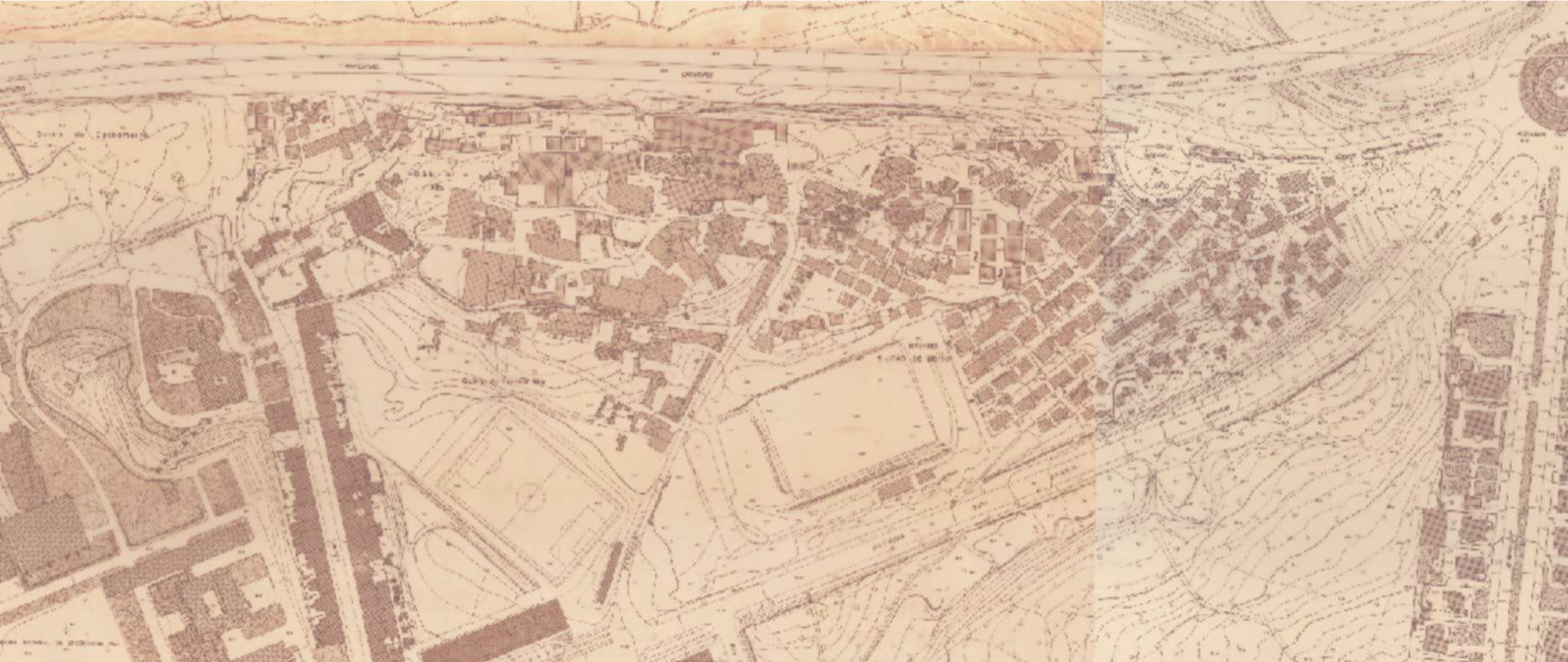

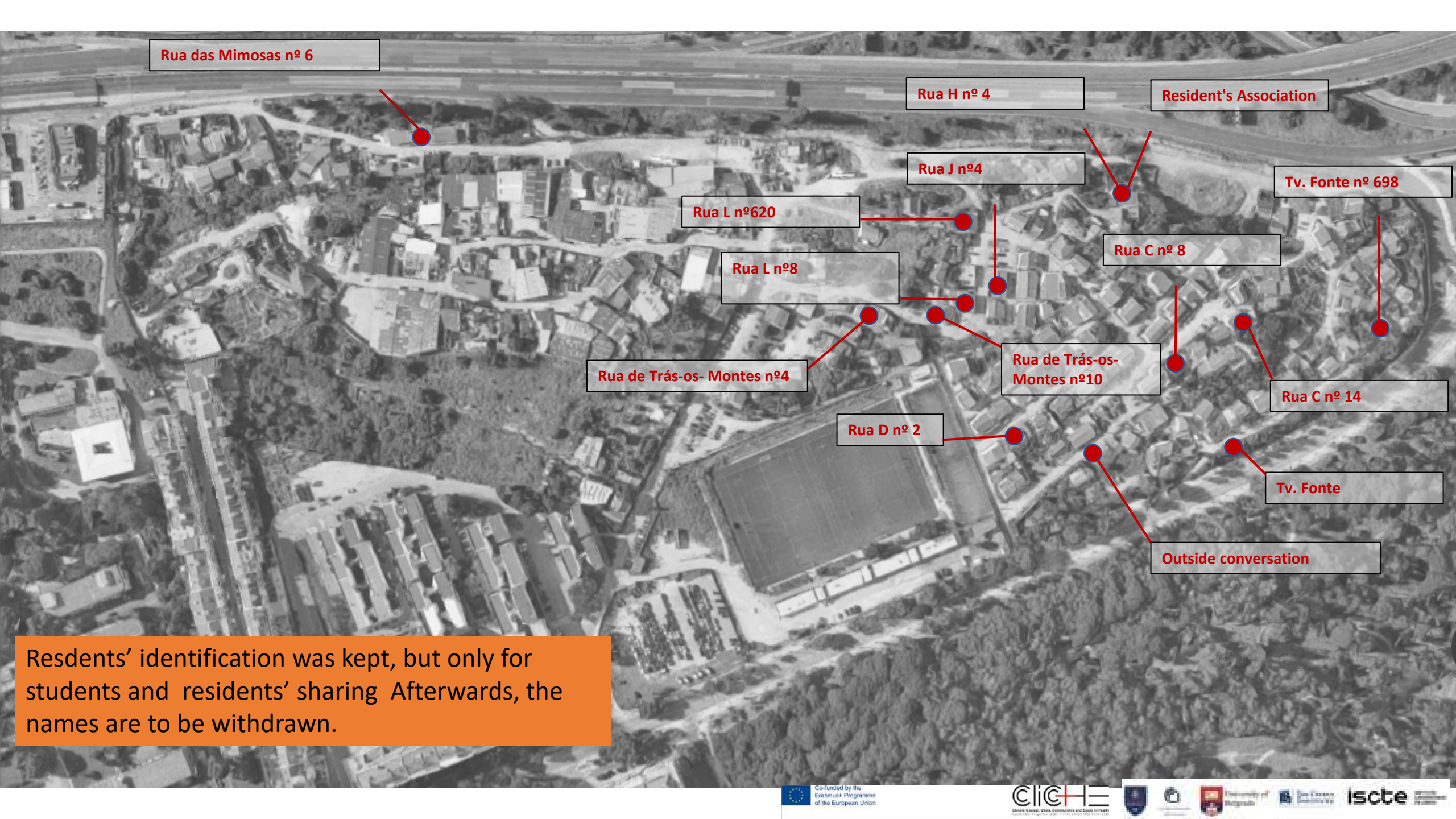

## Neighbourhood Timeline

- 1960 aprox.** Beginning of the building process – first houses  
Migratory movements
- 1975/1976** “Retornados” and other neighbourhoods’ residents within Lisbon or in its outskirts  
The city hall verbally gives permission
- 1980 aprox.** Foundation of the Residents’ Association  
Several attempts of resettlement
- 2012** The neighbourhood is no longer inside the restrictive airport perimeter. (process 1023/95.5TVLSB de 28.12.2012 – agreement between the Portuguese State and Lisbon City Hall)  
Lisbon’s Master Plan Revision (approval:24.07.2012)
- 2017** Process regularization start - land subdivision operation (process nº 11/URB/2017)\*

- today**
- Legalization
  - Dwelling property
  - Urban improvement work/Public equipment
  - Construction workd/Green Areas/Services







# DWELLERS



**Resident:  
Nowadays, it's pretty.  
But we had to struggle.**



**One of the residents built their house in the neighborhood with a verbal and informal permit, but only if it was built like a shed - "casa abarracada"**

**Many residents come from the country side of Portugal . One said that people maintain their gardens to keep a little bit of the country side with them. He asked me to think of the neighborhood as a small village.**



# DWELLERS

Young resident: when people from outside referred to S. João de Brito as a shantytown she started asserting: "Yes, I live in a shed. Mine is the yellow one."



Student: there is a belief that cafes enhance drugs and gambling so they disappeared after the public renovation work.

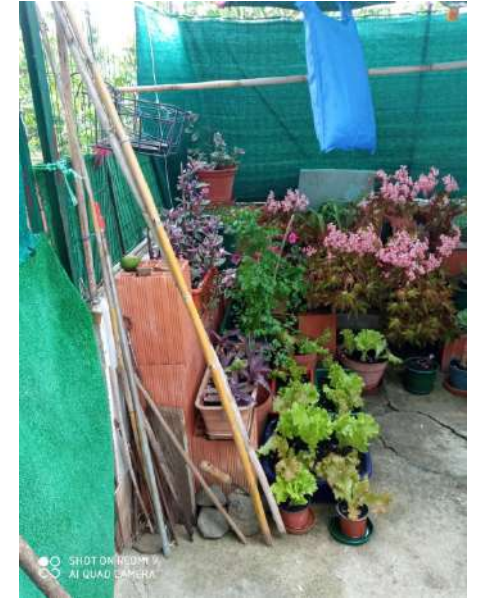






# Green Areas

- Gardens
- Vegetable gardens

One of the residents creates a path by cutting their bushes so that their neighbor can go through it and save walking time, after the public work changed the streets



Resident:

**Resident: the heat and smell of fuel are higher in the neighborhood due to proximity to the airport**



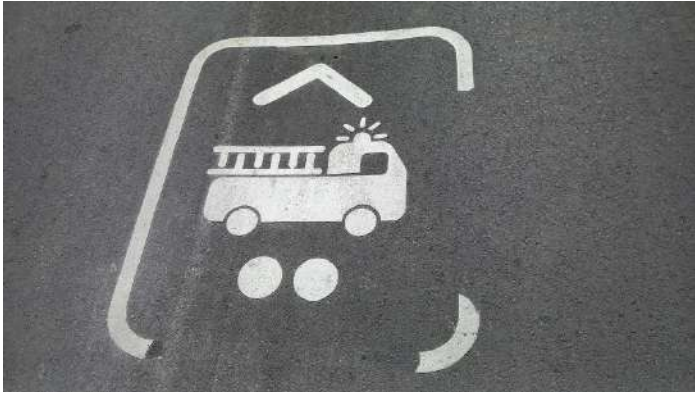
**Some houses were built on unstable landfill terrain**
